

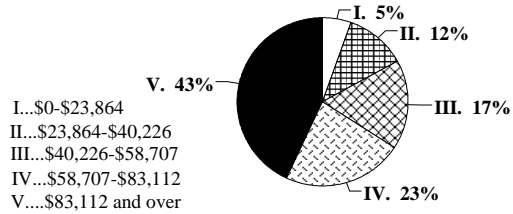

| Richest fifth vs. middle fifth | 26 |

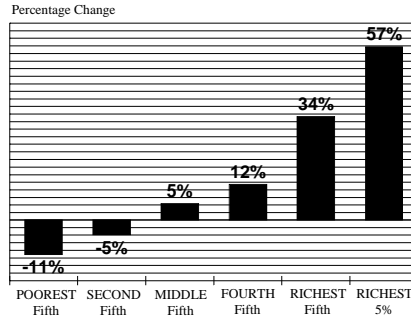
Share of Income Held by Each Income Fifth, Late 1990s

| | Dollar Change | % Change |
|-----------------------|---------------|----------|
| Poorest Fifth . . . | -\$1,790* | -11% |
| Middle Fifth | \$2,510* | 5% |
| Richest Fifth | \$34,740* | 34% |
| Richest 5% | \$84,420* | 57% |

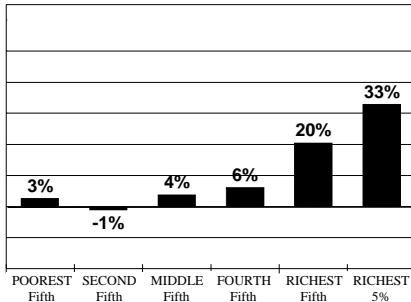
Income Change for Ohio Families Late 1970s to Late 1990s, by Fifth of Families



Inflation-Adjusted Change in Incomes Late 1980s to Late 1990s

| | Dollar Change | % Change |
|-----------------------|---------------|----------|
| Poorest Fifth . . . | \$360 | 3% |
| Middle Fifth | \$1,780* | 4% |
| Richest Fifth | \$23,080* | 20% |
| Richest 5% | \$57,370* | 33% |
